



2024 Trinity River Crew Job Description

Position: Trinity River Crew Member

Locations: DFW Metroplex

Dates and Schedule: June 11- August 2, 2024. Tuesday – Friday 7:00 am – 1:00 pm.

We will have a week long break (July 2-5) and will resume the program on (Jul 9).

Compensation: \$11.15/hr, 24 hrs/week for 7 weeks; paid every two (2) weeks

You must receive consent from your parents or legal guardians to join the program.

Overview:

The Trinity River Crew provides meaningful, paid conservation work experience, education, leadership skills, and professional development training to high-potential youth along the Trinity River. The goals of the Trinity River Crew are to promote environmental awareness, protect and restore green infrastructure and natural resources, and engage participants in meaningful conservation, community development, and stewardship projects around community parks and public spaces at the Trinity River. Crews will be comprised of 13 youth and led by two (2) youth leaders and two (2) adult coordinators. Week 1 is mandatory training followed by 6 weeks of conservation projects and environmental education experiences at the Trinity River in Dallas.

Essential Program Functions:

- Ability to work collaboratively with a diverse group of people for 7 weeks.
- Physical ability to be outside for 6 hours a day performing tasks such as lifting, bending, carrying heavy objects or tools, engaging in repetitive motions, and potentially hiking hilly terrain often carrying tools.

Note: Lunch and snacks will be provided. No prior experience is required – members will be trained on all equipment.

Qualifications

- High school students, ages 14-18
- Motivation, positive attitude, and interest in conservation work
- Willingness to follow instructions and complete assignments
- Willingness to work in the outdoors and in wilderness areas despite weather conditions, high temperatures, and possible inclement weather
